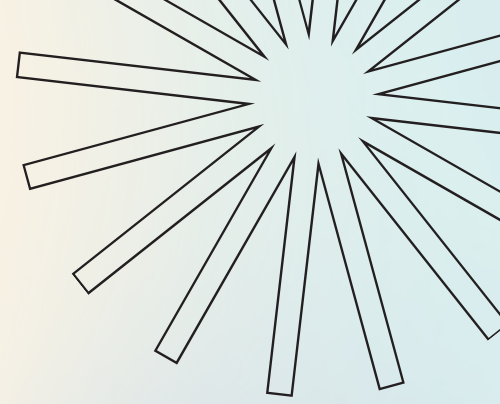

Discuss This

- Read Acts 28:2 - How is kindness described in this verse?
- Is it especially important to be kind to strangers? Why or why not?
- Read Titus 3:4-7 - Where is kindness seen most clearly?
- Why is God interested in US being kind?
- The word "kindness" is the Greek word "chrestotes" and it literally means "to put at ease". - How does a kind person put you at ease?
- Why should Christians have a reputation as being kind? Do you think most Christians do? Do you think YOU do?
- What does kindness have to do with your witness to others who don't know God?
- How can being kind create opportunities for you to share the truth of God with others?
- Read Luke 6:38 - What does this verse say about kindness?
- What do we RECEIVE when we give kindness to others?
- Is that a good motivation to be kind? What motivation do YOU need to be kind?
- Is the fact that God is kind and expects us to be kind motivation enough?
